Frequently Asked Questions

1. Why is making a pledge so important? I put money in the offering plate or contribute through PayPal each week.

We are grateful for all offerings, but there is no way to effectively create a budget on the basis of loose offerings. If you have been putting off making a pledge, NOW is the time!

2. What are the ways to pay my pledge?

- a. Place your pledge in the offering plate each week
- b. Automatic transfer from your checking account
- c. Mail or drop off in the church office

You are free to allocate any part of your pledge to outreach by designating the amount or percentage you wish to give to NCC outreach missions. "Outreach has been renamed "Faith in Action" to signify its focus on members working to maximize our church's impact on mercy and justice causes.
